

The Level 3 Diploma in Accounting (Part-time) is the second stage of the full AAT qualification, for those who have completed the Level 2 Certificate in Accounting. It is a professional course which will give you the skills to excel at a wide range of accounting and finance jobs.

On the Level 3 Diploma you are introduced to more advanced bookkeeping and final accounts preparation techniques.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

To study a Level 3 qualification, you will need:

Level 2 AAT Accountancy qualification or equivalent, along side GCSE English and maths at grade 4 or FS Level 2 English and maths, or equivalent. If you have substantial industry experience this may be considered at interview.

Satisfactory interview and/or assessment

ASSESSMENT METHOD

By computer based assessments that are externally marked.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A requirement of this course is membership with the AAT (The Association of Accounting Technicians). This will come at a cost.

It is advantageous to pay this as soon as possible, in order to gain access to the wide range of learning resources available from the AAT.

Please be aware that criminal offences, bankruptcy and IVAs will affect your application for membership with the AAT. See course leader for further details.

Initial unit exams are included in the course fees. Exam resits are an extra cost, which at Level 3 is £60 for all exams. There is also an extra cost for course textbooks, which is approximately £60.

If you are able to access this course for free, you should be aware that you are still required to pay for the extra fees to AAT, any exam resits, and the course books, although you can also apply for a college bursary to help with a contribution towards these costs.
