Initial unit exams are included in the course fees. Exam resits are an extra cost, which at Level 3 is £60 for all exams. There is also an extra cost for course textbooks, which is approximately £60. If you are able to access this course for free, you should be aware that you are still required to pay for the extra fees to AAT, any exam resits, and the course books, although you can also apply for a college bursary to help with a contribution towards these costs.
