



Advanced Level Apprenticeship for IT Professionals - C060

This Apprenticeship programme is designed for new entrants to a role in the IT & Telecoms sector, and to provide progression and re-skilling routes for existing IT Professionals. Apprentices can work in areas such as: Software & Web Development, Technical Support, Telecommunications, IT Project Management.

COURSE DETAILS

This course is designed to prepare learners for employment in the IT and Telecoms sector and is suitable for those who have decided that they wish to enter a specific area of work within the IT and Telecoms industry. Competence Element: Level 3 Diploma in Professional Competence for IT and Telecoms Professionals - Total of 72 credits consisting of Mandatory units (12 credits) Personal Effectiveness and Health and Safety plus Optional units suited to your field of work (60 credits). Knowledge Element: BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma in IT - 6 units studied over a period of one year attending college one day per week. Functional Skills: Functional Maths Level 2, Functional English Level 2, Functional ICT Level 2, Personal Learning & Thinking Skills: Mapped to Competence qualification.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

Apprentices must be in paid employment of at least 30 hours a week. Candidates who already have a qualification at Level 4 or higher are not eligible. Applicants will have achieved 5 GCSEs at grade C or above. If English is not your first language, you may need an English Language assessment before enrolling on this course.
