

The Plastering Level 2 Diploma is designed to develop the skills and knowledge of students, enabling them to work in the industry in their chosen craft. It has been specifically developed for delivery in a training environment using simulated conditions.

- Unit 201: Health, safety and welfare in construction
- Unit 202: Principles of building construction, information and communication
- Unit 221: Apply plastering materials to interiors
- Unit 222: Fix dry lining and plasterboard to interiors
- Unit 223: Lay sand and cement screeds
- Unit 224: Apply plastering materials to exteriors
- Unit 225: Produce reverse moulds for fibrous
- Unit 226: Casting and fixing fibrous plasterwork

This is a Study Programme for those aged 16-18 years of age.

Relevant level 1 qualification in plastering and minimum of 3 GCSEs at Grade 3/D or above and relevant practical experience.

Satisfactory interview, school report and / or reference.
