



## IMI Diploma in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair (19+ adult only) - E026

This Level 3 Diploma is designed for individuals who are passionate about automotive maintenance and repair. It provides advanced skills and knowledge required to diagnose and fix complex vehicle issues, preparing you for a successful career in the automotive industry.

### COURSE DETAILS

This course enhances the learning of Level 2 and completes the VRQ section of study which is the technical element of assessment. It includes both practical and diagnostic assessment units required for progression into apprenticeships.

Topics covered include:

- Routine vehicle maintenance
- Removal and replacement of vehicle units
- Diagnosis and rectification of vehicle faults
- Fitting and replacing vehicle tyres

A relevant Level 2 qualification in automotive maintenance and repair or significant industry experience.

Basic literacy and numeracy skills.

### EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

We require you to have Personal Protective Equipment and a small tool kit.
