ASSESSMENT METHOD

The end of course assessment is in two parts.1.The multi-format examination paper comprises a mix of multiple choice and objective questions.2..A practical risk assessment based project carried out in the delegates own workplace.Successful delegates are awarded an IOSH Managing Safely certificate.
