The RSPH Level 2 Award in Food Allergen Awareness has been designed to help food handlers:

- Understand the impact of food allergy and intolerance
- Identify, manage and control the risks associated with food allergens
- Apply the principles of practical allergen management to develop good practice in the workplace
- Provide allergen information, with confidence

COURSE DETAILS

Within the course the following topics will be covered:

- Allergy and intolerance
- Food labelling
- Recognising hazards
- Cross-contamination
- Correct storage and handling
- Correct food preparation
- Information to be recorded
- Risk Assessment

The tutor will use a range of teaching methods during the course which will include the following; group work, formative assessment, discussion, question and answer sessions.
