This qualification is aimed at supervisors, team leaders and line managers working in the catering industry. Learners gaining this qualification will know and be able to apply their knowledge at all stages of food production. Applicants should have communication and comprehension skills, at level 1 as there is a multiple choice assessment at the end of the course.
