



Military Preparation Diploma L3 - PS307

This course is designed to prepare you and point you in the right direction to achieve quality employment in the Royal Navy, Army, Royal Air Force or Royal Marines.

You will be expected to demonstrate a high degree of personal responsibility and motivation throughout this course to a standard expected of military personnel. You will develop your leadership skills and learn to take the initiative and become more proactive in how you manage your work.

COURSE DETAILS

There will be visits to military establishments to give you an insight into the work of the Armed Services. There will be day trips, as well as a number of residential trips lasting anything between one night to four nights away from home. Although the course is practically based you will need to build a portfolio of work to support your course.

You will study 4 mandatory units and 2 optional units:

- Preparing for Employment in the uniformed services
- Physical fitness
- Develop Leadership skills
- Understanding Discipline
- Understanding war and conflict
- Adventurous activities
- Service routine
- Telecommunications in emergency situations

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- Level 3 courses are usually 2 years in length.
- You will need 4 GCSE's at Grade 4 or above. One of the 4 GCSE's to be Maths or English at Grade 4 (or functional skill level 2) to study at this level.
- If you have a level 2 qualification in the subject you want to study and a maths or English GCSE at Grade 4 (or functional skill level 2) you can study at this level.
- Entry requirements for Level 3 courses in some sectors may be more specific. If you're unsure whether you meet these requirements, don't worry — we can help you find a suitable course that aligns with your skills and experience.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Military standards of attendance and punctuality are expected. You will be tutored by ex-military personnel who have a wide range of experience, and who will expect a lot of you. You will be expected to take up the opportunity to undertake work experience and/or residential experiences (up to 5 days) across all four services while you are on the course.

Are you aged 16-18?

Study programmes are full-time courses for 16-18 year olds which include:

- A qualification such as BTEC Extended Diploma
- Meaningful work experience or preparation for work
- English and maths, if you don't already have GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C) in English and maths (Grade 4 or above)
- Non-study activities such as tutorials, voluntary work, fund-raising/charity work, sport or trips

WHERE CAN I PROGRESS TO?

The Diploma is for those students who have completed the Certificate and are not quite ready to enter into the Military. Those who are not quite ready at the end of the Diploma course can progress onto Level 3 Extended Diploma in Military preparation for a further year. All courses carry UCAS points.
