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What are T Levels?

T Levels are a nationally recognised two-year qualification designed to give you a head start towards the future you want.

They follow GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A Levels.

The 2-year qualification brings classroom and work placement together, on a course endorsed by and designed with employers.

Entry requirements

T Level	Entry requirements	
Digital Support Services	Minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade A* - C/9 - 4, including English Language, Maths and an IT-related GCSE such as IT, Computing or Computer Science.	
Education & Childcare - Early Years Educator	Minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade A* - C/9 - 4, including English Language and Maths.	
Onsite Construction - Carpentry & Joinery	Minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade A* - C/9 - 4, including English Language and Maths.	





If you're not quite ready for a T Level or don't quite achieve the grades and would still like to do a T Level there is the option of a one-year Transition Programme, which will then allow you to move on to a T Level the following year and gain a qualification at the same time.

The T Level Transition Programme is a **1-year post-GCSE course**. It will give you relevant knowledge, practical and study skills to excel in your subject.

What's the difference between a T Level and an Apprenticeship?

T Level	Apprenticeship
20% on an extended placement: gives an overview of different roles and career routes within an industry.	80% in the workplace.
80% classroom-based developing knowledge and skills for jobs.	20% off the job training i.e. an employment opportunity with training for those who are keen on working in a specific role.
You do not get paid for your industry placement on the T Level course, however you may be eligible for the 'T Award' which includes a £300 per year bursary*.	Paid.



Where can I progress to after achieving my T Level?

- ✓ Employment in a skilled occupation in your chosen career
- ✓ A Level 4, 5 or Degree Apprenticeship
- ✓ Higher level study, such as a Higher National Certificate / Diploma, technical or professional qualification or a Degree at university.



Can I go to uni with a T Level?

T Level grades are worth UCAS points in the same way as A Levels or BTECs. A Distinction* at T Level is worth 168 UCAS points (equivalent to 3 x A* at A Level).

Upon successful completion of our T Level courses you will be guaranteed a place on a degree programme at Wirral Met College.

△ ABOUT THE COURSE

If you like working with children then this is the course for you!

The T Level Education and Childcare qualification will equip you with the skills, knowledge and industry experience to start your journey in this rewarding sector.

The core element of a T Level in Education and Childcare will boost your knowledge in a range of topics such as child development, safeguarding and special educational needs; as well as your understanding of the role of families and support agencies. You'll also dive into the specifics of social interaction, behaviour, and how language is acquired, as well as build your skills in becoming a reflective practitioner.

You will then get the opportunity to specialise at Wirral Met College in Early Years Education.

Then you'll be able to put everything you learn into practice, with a substantial industry placement of a minimum 21 weeks (750 hours). Giving you an amazing opportunity to work with an employer while you study, such as a school or nursery, and gain invaluable experience as well as key skills that employers are looking for.
