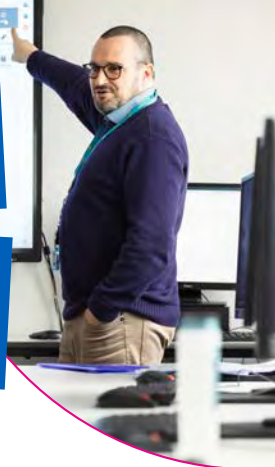

If you take out an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the fees for an Access to HE course, and then successfully complete a degree, you don't have to repay the outstanding loan for the Access to HE course.

NEW FE TEACHER TRAINING FUNDING AVAILABLE

You may be eligible for a Further Education (FE) Initial Teacher Education (ITE) bursary. These are tax-free amounts you receive to train in certain subjects. You do not need to pay them back.

Time is running out to apply! Awards will be made from a finite government funding pot on a first-come-first-served basis, so when the money is gone, it's gone.

- **Get up to £29,000 tax free* for courses starting September 2024-25**
 - Maths
 - Sciences including biology, chemistry and/or physics

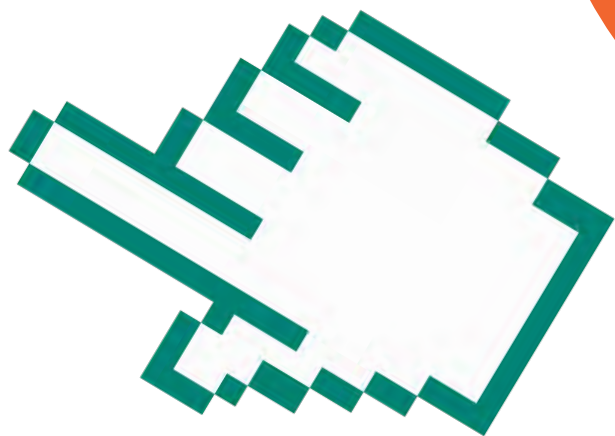

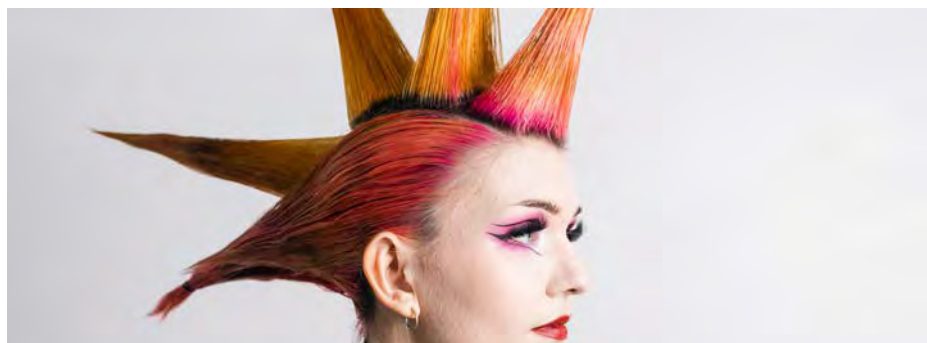

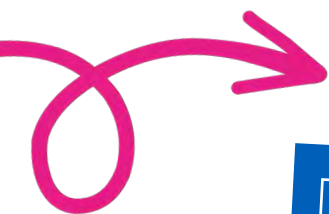
